

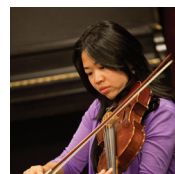
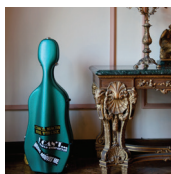

Sunday, June 23 at 2 p.m.
Shiley Theatre, Camino Hall

Two-week Summer Festival for musicians of all ages and levels. Adult participants attend evening and weekend sessions with optional day sessions, and student participants attend morning and weekend sessions. Advanced student musicians age 15 and older may also apply to participate in evening sessions.

Cost: \$515 for adults (age 18 or older) or \$425 for students (all ages); and \$45 for six tickets to any of the ticketed concerts during the Summer Festival.
