Sixteen-year old Bradley Carpiuc is the First-Place Winner in the 2024 Music Teachers' Association of California (MTAC) State Piano Concerto Competition as both the Southern California Regional Winner and overall State Winner. The honor is an addition to over two dozen top awards he has received in regional, state, national and international piano contests since he started playing the piano at the age of six.

Bradley has been featured with many San Diego area orchestras, among them the Greater San Diego Chamber Orchestra, Mira Costa Symphony Orchestra, Grossmont Symphony Orchestra, and the Mainly Mozart Youth Orchestra.

Besides playing the piano, Bradley is an accomplished composer. His pieces have been described as bold, sophisticated, and well-crafted. He was recently selected into the Young Composer's Guild, a 5-year tenure and the highest achievement awarded by the MTAC Composers Today program.

Bradley is co-founder and contributing writer of Cadence Corner, an online blog led by student musicians to increase the accessibility of musical resources and content. He also holds an annual fundraising concert for charity.

Bradley is a student of Dr. Anna Savvas on the piano and Mr. Justin Weiss for composition. Outside music, Bradley enjoys math, geography and vexillology, video-editing, and spending time with his friends and family.
